#### **Short UMI Overview**

September 21 (Sunday), Olissippo Oriente Hotel, 19:30h: Welcome Reception

September 22, 23 and 24 (Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday), Pavilhão do Conhecimento (Pavillion of Knowledge) - Ciência Viva, 08:30h: **Technical Sessions**. Other activities include **Oceanàrio**, **Banquet**, and a **Spouses-only Lisbon Tour**.

September 24 through 26 (Wednesday late afternoon, Thursday, and Friday): GEOTECHNICAL FIELD TOURS, one to the central Portugal and two to south Portugal. Leave Lisbon hotel on Wednesday, visit mines on Thursday, travel to Algarve on Friday, and depart on Saturday, September 27, unless participating in strategic planning meeting below. Field Tour Fee covers 2 hotel nights-24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup>, bus, entry fees, breakfast and lunch; dinners are no-host). NOTE: Our host can assist with making a separate hotel reservation for the evening of September 26, which is not included in field tour fee.

This involves steering committees (technical, environmental, and education), formed in 2013. #### Group/Bus 1 (30 people, Neves Corvo Mine)


7:30h – Leave the hotel to the Neves Corvo mine

- 3 Visit to the ore processing facilities (copper/zinc plants);

## September 25 (Thursday)

#### Bus 2 (30 people/ Aljustrel mine group)

- 3 Visit to the ore processing facilities (copper/zinc plants; 19 people)

**14:00h** – Visit to the Lousal Mining Village (old pyrite mine, closed since 1988)

- 1 Welcome and introduction to the general characteristics of the RELOUSAL Program – Environmental, social, economic and patrimonial rehabilitation of the Lousal Mining Village
- 2 Visit to the Lousal Open Pit / underground gallery (Valdemar gallery)/ and environmental rehabilitation initiatives
- 3 Visit to the Mining Museum of Lousal
- 4 Visit to the Science Centre of Lousal Mine of Science
- 5 Auditorium of Lousal: (i) View of a documentary on the Lousal mine operation in 1958; (ii) View of a video on the current activity of the Lousal Science Centre; (iii) Q&A and discussion
- 19:00h No-host Dinner at the Restaurant Armazém Central (Lousal); regional gastronomy accompanied by songs performed by a Choral Group of Lousal Miners

21:00h – Leave Lousal

**21:30h** – Arrival to the *Hotel Vila Galé Clube de Campo* (same hotel)





### September 26 (Friday)

#### Group/Bus 1 and Group/Bus 2 (60 people in total)

(No special field gear is required; comfortable and fresh clothes/hiking shoes are advised)

Travel to Algarve through the Alentejo coast (geoturistic field trip)

8:00h – Hotel check out and travel depart

**9:30h** – Stop 1 – Almograve Beach (37°39'11.58"N; 8°48'03.91"W) – Easy walk along the cliff and beach; beautiful natural scenery and landscape; outstanding geologic outcrops.

**12:30h** – Leave Almograve beach towards South.

**13:30h** – Stop 2 - Arrifana beach (37°39'11.58"N; 8°48'03.91"W); Lunch at a restaurant on top of a cliff with an exceptional view over the sea (excellent grilled fish and seafood);

**15:30h** – Leave Arrifana beach towards South.

16:30h – Stop 3 – Carrapateira village / Amado beach (37°10'22.78"N; 8°54'17.78"W); Triassic and Lower Jurassic geology – spectacular outcrops; brief coffee/beverage/sweet stop

**18:00h** – Leave Carrapateira towards South.

**18:30h** – Stop 4 – Sagres cape – historical place (Portuguese Nautical Discoveries); exceptional landscape; beautiful geology.

19:00h - Leave Sagres towards East.

20:15h - Stop 5 (final destination at Algarve) - Albufeira. Arrival to the hotel and check in
